

Honolulu Federal Credit Union dba HOCU 2020 - 2021 HOCU Rising Star Scholarship Program

Dear Student and HOCU Member:

Honolulu Federal Credit Union (dba HOCU) is offering up to five (5) \$2,000 scholarships to qualified member-applicants who have been accepted into, or are already enrolled in, a trade school/community college/university program (including online courses), at any two-or four-year institution of higher learning for the 2020-2021 academic year. Recipients must be enrolled as full-time students, be primary members of HOCU in good standing, and be willing to have their picture published.

For consideration of a scholarship, the following criteria will be used:

Academic Merit -cumulative GPA of 2.5 - 3.2 = 5 points, 3.3 - 4.04 = 10 points Achievements, Awards, Extracurricular Activities – 10 points Community Service – 15 points Personal Essay – 50 points The total maximum points an applicant can receive is 85.

Financial information disclosed by the applicant will only be used to determine financial need for this scholarship and will be held in strict confidence by HOCU, its employees, volunteers, and committee members.

1. Am I eligible to apply?

An applicant must be a primary member of HOCU and must be accepted and planning to enroll as a full-time student at an institution of higher learning such as a Trade School, Community College or University. Enrolling as a full-time student taking online courses also qualifies you as an applicant. You are a primary member of HOCU if you receive a statement with your name listed and have a regular share account with a minimum of \$5.

2. Can my parent, grandparent, or guardian apply for me?

No one else can submit the application for an applicant. You, the applicant, must apply yourself, and be the primary member of a HOCU account.

3. <u>How do I apply?</u>

Go to our website at <u>www.myhocu.com</u> to download the scholarship information.

Once completed, send all the following documentation in **ONE envelope:**

- 1) Scholarship Form
- 2) Official Transcript
- 3) Two Letters of Recommendation
- 4) Personal Essay
- 5) List of Achievements, Awards, and Extra-Curricular Activities

4. Are there any deadlines?

Completed application must be postmarked no later than <u>June 10, 2020</u> and all applicants will be notified by mail by the Scholarship Committee no later than <u>July 31,2020</u> The check will be payable and mailed to the School/University you are enrolled in for the 2020 fall semester. If you do not enroll in the 2020 fall semester, you will become ineligible for the scholarship funds.

5. Are there any marketing requirements expected of me, if I am awarded a

scholarship?

Yes, the scholarship recipient will be asked to participate in a photo opportunity for HOCU, and/or could be asked to participate in a speaking engagement.



6. Can I contest the selection?

No, the HOCU Scholarship Committee selections are final.

7. What can my scholarship funds be used for?

The scholarship funds may be used for all educational expenses such as tuition, books, fees, supplies, room and board, and miscellaneous education-related expenses.

8. <u>Is the scholarship taxable?</u>

Please consult a tax expert for advice.

9. How will the Scholarship Committee know if a transcript is "official"?

Your academic school/university should seal the official transcript in an envelope bearing the school address and/or logo, with your name on the outside of the envelope.

10. Who can I ask to write letters of recommendation for me?

Your two letters of recommendation should be <u>current</u> letters from individuals, such as teachers, coaches, or advisors, who have worked with you within the last school year and can attest to your character and work or study ethics. These individuals must not be related to or living with you.

11. What should I address in my personal essay?

Focus your personal essay on two of the three questions below in order to persuade members of the Scholarship Committee to award you this scholarship. The essay should be typed, double-spaced, a minimum of 12-point text and no more than 2 pages long.

Upon graduation from college, where do you envision your career taking you in the next 10 years?

Has any community service project you participated in within the last year helped guide you towards the career you will be choosing? Explain why.

Is there a challenging event in your life that you were able to overcome and grow from that experience?

12. May I receive more than one scholarship from the HOCU?

Scholarship recipients are not eligible for another HOCU scholarship in the future. HOCU would like to provide this opportunity to other member-applicants.

13. If I do not receive a scholarship this year, may I apply again next year?

Yes, you are eligible to submit your application again in a subsequent year by completing the application in its entirety by the stated deadline.
