

UPDATE TO FUNDS VAILABILITY POLICY



HOCU is updating our Funds Availability Policy. Effective July 1, 2025, HOCU will be required to provide \$275.00 for next day availability for all instances where it was required to provide a minimum of \$225.00. In addition, the \$5,525.00 availability requirements for holds on new accounts, large deposits, and repeat overdrafts will increase to \$6,725.00. The final rule also establishes a timetable for future adjustments with the next adjustment expected on July 1, 2030 and continuing every fifth year thereafter.
